BREVE DESCRIPCION DEL CONTENIDO: Estructura de la lengua. Gramática, semántica y léxico.

OBJETIVOS:

1. Descripción y práctica de las estructuras de la lengua inglesa en sus niveles morfológico, sintáctico y léxico.
2. Estudio de los conceptos fundamentales de la Sintaxis y de la Semántica, con especial referencia a la Semántica Léxica.
3. Aplicación de los conocimientos morfosintácticos y semánticos adquiridos al uso real de la lengua inglesa en los diferentes contextos de comunicación.

CONTENIDOS:

1. **VERBAL GROUP.** Concepts of time, tense, aspect and modality.
2. **Verb forms.** Active and Passive, Simple and Continuous. The parts of the main verb. Formation of the negative. Formation of questions.
3. **Phrasal verbs.** Word order in phrasal verbs. Common particles (adverbs and prepositions) used in the formation of phrasal verbs.
4. **Tenses.** Form, meaning and uses. The two elements of meaning: time and attitude. The Present tenses. The Past tenses. The Perfect tenses.
5. **The Imperative.** Form, meaning and uses.
6. **The Passive.** Form, meaning and uses. use of 'by' and 'with'. Use of the structure 'Have something done by'.
7. **The Future.** Form, meaning and uses. Future with 'shall'/'will'. Future with 'going to'. Other ways of expressing the future.
8. **Modals.** Form, meaning and uses. Modal verbs and related structures. Probability. Obligation, Necessity, Ability, Permission, etc.
9. **Conditional sentences.** Different types of conditionals (I, II and III).



10. **Sentence patterns.** Transitive and Intransitive verbs. The Infinitive. The '-ing' form: participle or gerund.
11. **Sentence constructions.** Conjunctions (Linking word). Direct Speech and Reported Speech. Relative clauses.
12. **Appendix.** Irregular verbs. Contractions. Punctuation. Main differences between British and American English.
13. **SEMANTICS.** Words and their meaning. Affective meaning. Style, register, dialect and accent. Sense relations. Polysemy, Homonymy, Synonymy, Hyponymy, Antonymy. Multi-word verbs. Idioms.
14. **Componential analysis.** Components of meaning. Meaning relations. Taxonomic oppositions. Polar oppositions. relative oppositions. Redundancy rules. Marked and unmarked terms.
15. **Interpersonal meaning.** Speech acts. Perlocutionary act and Illocutionary act. Conversational implicature.
16. **Semantics and the Dictionary.** Practical dictionaries and theoretical dictionaries.
